

IFR Membership Fee Structure

(valid from 2007)

Industry Association

“An Industry Association member shall be a national or supra-national association representing robot manufacturers or integrators in the respective geographical area. It must have independent financial resources and must support industrial, technical and scientific activities in the field of robotics.

From each geographical area only one association can be an Industry Association member. If, before an applicant from one geographical area has been accepted as a member by the Executive Board, there are additional applicants for membership from the same geographical area, the Executive Board with a vote of three-quarters of its members present shall decide about admission of the additional applicant to membership.”

- Category (a): The association represents over 10 000 operational industrial robots in its geographical area.

annual fee: 3 500 €

- Category (b): The association represents less than 10 000 operational industrial robots in its geographical area.

annual fee: 1 500 €

R&D Institute

“A R&D Institute shall be a University, research centre or an organization, undertaking, as a major focus of its work, research and development activities in the field of robotics.”

annual fee: 1 200€

Partner

“A Partner shall be robot manufacturer or integration company as well as university, research centre, organization, company or individual not otherwise eligible for membership, being interested in the IFR activities and in the field of robotics.”

annual fee: 1 500€
